Over \$262,000 in cash, prizes and scholarships was awarded to student participants in the 46<sup>th</sup> Annual 2005 Bay Area Science and Engineering Fair on Saturday, April 1, 2006.

More than 400 students from grades 7 – OAC in Hamilton, Halton, Brant, Haldimand and Norfolk spent months preparing over 288 amazing science and engineering projects. More than half of the students received Merit or Special Awards. **All** student participants were rewarded for their efforts with a gift bag that included Microsoft software, BASEF tee shirt, Sympatico music download coupons and the opportunity to attend the all expenses paid Activity Day event at Canada Marine Discovery Centre.

Each of the 137 Gold, Silver or Bronze medalists received a \$500 entrance scholarship to be redeemed upon acceptance at either or Mohawk College or the Sheridan College Institute of Technology and Advanced Learning.

Twenty of the top winners of the Bay Area Science and Engineering Fair were awarded all expense paid Grand Trip Awards to compete at either the Canada Wide Science Fair (CWSF) in Saquenay, Quebec (May 14-21) or the Intel International Science and Engineering Fair (IISEF) in Indianapolis, Indiana, (May 7-14).

Aaron Hakim, a grade 9 student from Appleby College in Oakville, won the BASEF Best in Fair Pinnacle Award. Aaron's project explored whether caloric restriction and/or antioxidant supplements such as Thymoquinone and Vitamin E affected aging. Aaron will be travelling to compete at CWSF.

Kayla Cornale, a grade 11 student at Assumption High School in Burlington won the BASEF 2<sup>nd</sup> place Pinnacle Award and a trip to CWSF. Kayla was previously selected to compete at IISEF as a member of Team Canada, along with two other BASEF students, Alexander Molloy and Benjamin Gulak.

Jordan Bowman, a grade 11 student from St. Mary's High School in Hamilton won the 3<sup>rd</sup> place Pinnacle Award.

There are few things that inspire more confidence in our future than listening to these enthusiastic young scientists discussing their research and results. The diverse project topics included the effects of antioxidants, whether date rate drugs can be detected, renewable energy applications, robotics and a teaching system for autistic children.
